



Dear Parents, Grandparents, and Friends of Windsor,

We would like to share some EXCITING news you may not have heard. The State of Georgia has created an incredible opportunity for individuals and C-Corporations to re-direct a portion of their Georgia state income tax to provide scholarships for eligible students to attend Georgia private schools.

**Georgia taxpayers can now take credit for helping kids!**

A 2008 law allows individuals and corporations to receive a Georgia income tax credit (and federal income tax deduction) for re-directing their state income tax payments to the Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program.

GOAL uses these contributions to provide private school scholarships to students who are eligible to enroll in Pre-K4 or kindergarten or who are transferring from a Georgia public school. Taxpayers can designate the school at which these scholarships will be awarded! This means that your contribution can be used to support children who want to attend Windsor Academy.

**How this helps you, the school, and the children**

You are already paying income taxes to the state. Why not re-direct some of those taxes to provide Georgia children with Greater Opportunities for Access to Learning (GOAL)?

When you re-direct your Georgia income taxes to GOAL, you can designate that the contribution be used to provide scholarships at Windsor. Thus, the school is able to:

1. increase the financial aid that it can offer new students,
2. increase school enrollment, and
3. increase the funds available to improve educational offerings.

**How you can participate**

We want to make it as easy as possible for you to contribute before the end of 2010, so that you may take this credit on your 2010 Georgia income tax return. Please see the documents on the Windsor Web site for the simple process to make a contribution before 12/31/2010.
