



Beginning in 2008, individuals, married couples, and C corporations are able to take a Georgia income tax credit (and federal charitable income tax deduction) for contributions made to Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program, a qualified student scholarship organization (SSO). These contributions may be designated to provide scholarships at Windsor Academy to students who are transferring from a Georgia public school.

Tax Filing Status	Tax Credit Limit
Individual Filer	\$1,000
Married Filing Jointly	\$2,500
Married Filing Separately	\$1,250
C Corporation	75% of GA Tax Liability
S Corp, LLC, partnership	Individual limits of owners

1. GOAL will Handle the Contribution Process:

If you provide the following to Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program, GOAL officials will handle all the paperwork associated with making your contribution:

- a) Complete the attached GOAL Scholarship Contribution Form
- b) Sign page 2 of the attached IT-QEE-TP1 pre-approval form
- c) Write a check payable to Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program

GOAL will complete and send your Form TP1 to the Georgia Department of Revenue. Once the DOR approves your proposed contribution and returns to GOAL the approved Form TP1, GOAL will deposit your contribution check, send you a copy of the approved Form TP1, and send you a Form IT-QEE-SSO1 acknowledging your contribution.

2. You Claim the Credit:

- File your Georgia income tax return and take the credit
(GOAL will send tax filing instructions early in 2010 to assist you)
