Computer – USB/Flash drive

If students have multiple classes, they need a different composition book for each class but they do not need multiples of coloring pencils, glue, or scissors

RENWEB

Many of our parents are not accessing information on their child that is available on Renweb. (Windsor's school operating system) You can find daily grades, test grades, homework, upcoming exams, etc. You will also be able to e-mail teachers and get responses within a day.

This will be the main source of future information, announcements, and school events, so please give Mrs. Giles your email address so that you can log on and be aware of things going on at our school and with your child. We send emails to parents at least once a day.

You can go to www.renweb.com to get to the Parents Web page and then follow directions. **Windsor's school code is wa-ga. Your user name is the email address you provided on your child's application. If your e-mail has changed or changes in the future, please let Mrs. Giles know.**

DRESS CODE (detailed version available in Student Handbook on website)

Middle and High school students:

May use the same book bags as last year. We may look at going to mesh or clear book bags in the future.

Jackets must be purchased from Graphic Guys or Lands End or can be a Windsor letter jacket or jacket (not hoodie) pertaining to a student's sport.

(Mrs. Giles would like to apologize to anyone given wrong information regarding jackets.)

Middle and High School students: Pants, shorts, skorts, jackets, etc. must be ordered from Lands End or the Graphic Guys and will have logo embroidered on all items. Shirts can be royal blue (all students are required to have 1 royal blue shirt), white or gray.

Students will be allowed to order Windsor logo sweatshirts from Graphic Guys to be worn during school day.

Elementary students (K4-4th grade)

Pants, skirts, shorts, jumpers can come from school uniform department in any store. They can wear their shirts from last year but as your child grows please replace with white, royal blue or gray.

PE UNIFORMS (Grades 5-12)

PE uniforms should be purchased from the Graphic Guys. We have sizing shorts and shirts for girls and boys in the office.

Students may still wear their PE uniforms from last year if they purchased the royal shorts and white PE t-shirts.

ATTENDANCE

Students missing more than 20 days during a school year will not receive credit for the class unless hospitalized in which case the student must enroll in a homebound program. See student handbook on website for more details on attendance.
